Information on the processing activity:

purposes of the processing activity:

We transmit personal data for sales purposes and for the processing of our orders within the WB Wittmann Tec Group GmbH group of companies ("WITTMANN Group"), Lichtblaustraße 10, 1220 Vienna.

Legal basis of the processing activity:

The processing is necessary for the performance of a contract or a pre-contractual measure pursuant to Article 6 (1) (b) of the GDPR and the processing is necessary to protect the legitimate interests of the controller or a third party pursuant to Article 4 (19) in conjunction with Article 6 (1) (f) of the GDPR. Article 6 (1) (f) of the GDPR and the interests or fundamental rights and freedoms of the data subject are not overridden. Pursuant to Recital 48 to the GDPR, we have a legitimate interest in transferring personal data to affiliated companies of the Group for internal administrative purposes, including the processing of personal data of customers and employees.

Categories of recipients:

Group of companies: The recipient of the data is one or more companies in our group of companies.

Data transfer to a third country:

There is no planned transfer of personal data to third parties in third countries. Within the Wittmann Group, data is also transferred to third countries for a specific purpose in accordance with Art 49 (1) c).

Additional information requirements:

Storage period of personal data:

The personal data will be deleted by us as soon as the purpose of storage ceases to apply and no legal regulation permits or requires further storage.

Rights of the data subject:

You have the right to obtain information (pursuant to Article 15 of the GDPR) from the controller about the personal data concerning you, as well as the right to rectification (Article 16 of the GDPR), erasure (Article 17 of the GDPR) and restriction of processing (Article 18(1) of the GDPR). Furthermore, you have the right to object to processing (Article 21 of the GDPR) and the right to data portability (Article 20 of the GDPR).
